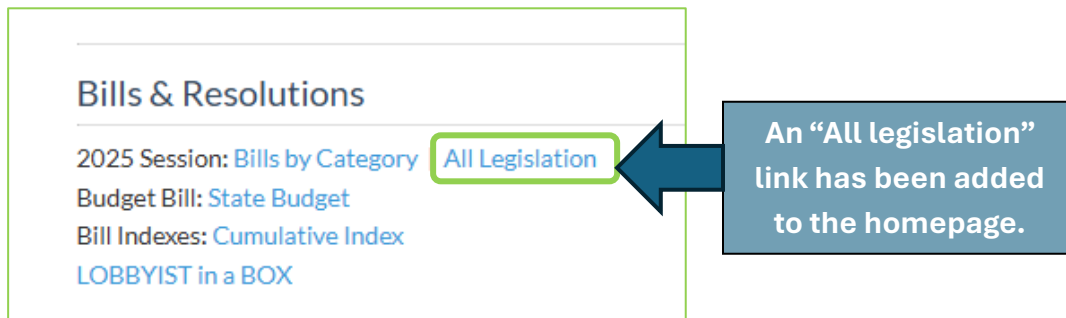


Usability updates

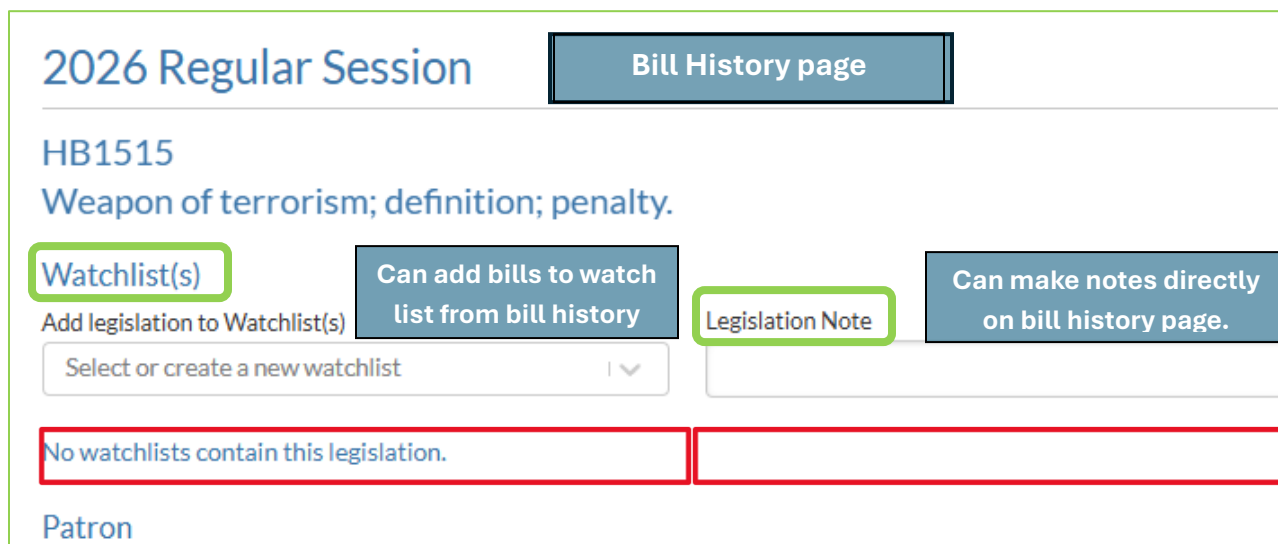
- Usability improved (more intuitive)
- Mobile browsing vastly improved
- Windows open in fewer tabs
- Improved search - for example, typing a bill number will take you directly to the bill history page.



Bill history page

Bill number remains persistent at top of page as you scroll through history

When logged in, bills can be added to watch lists and personal notes can be added from the bill history page.



Bill history and versions –

When an action modifies a bill, versions are linked on that bill history line.

When amendments are posted, the ‘parent’ document is included in the bill history line with the amendments:

Version that amendments are drawn to included with amendments in bill history

When a version is released in advance of a vote (such as a floor amendment, or conference reports), the history will note the version is offered.

Lobbyist-In-A-Box (LIAB)

Report link expiration is extended to 72 hours -- however, improved, *downloadable* report can be sent

Composite view Download improved – all relevant information linked to LIS history (include votes and notes!)

Personal Notes – Can be added from watch list page, bill history and composite view

Notifications

Options under My Watchlist Legislation will apply only to bills in current watchlist. (new options to notify when bill is placed on 2nd or 3rd reading)

Options under All Legislation apply to any bills this sessionon when a bill is on 2nd or 3rd reading.

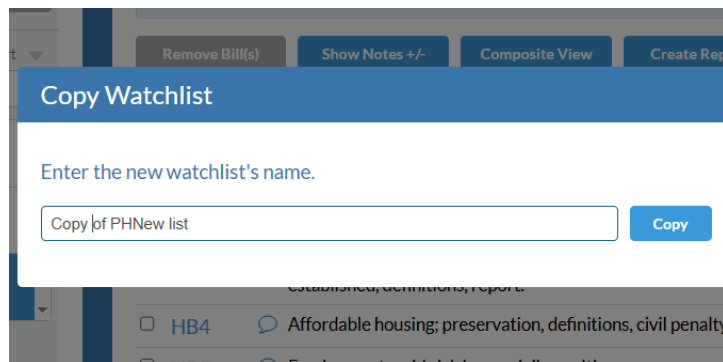
Watch lists

Adding bills to a watchlist – much improved; consistent interface throughout LIS

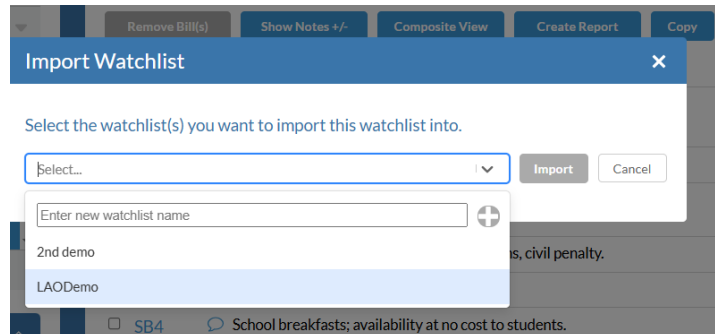
- New box added to drop down of watchlist names to create a new watch list on the fly
- Default sort of watchlists is now alpha / but can be sorted by create date
- Bills are in numerical order (rather than creation date order)

Add bills from search results to one or more watchlists

- Copy watchlist is new



- Import (formerly merge) sends a bill list into what list is currently displayed.



- Adding bills provides enhanced feedback and tells what is already there, what is added, etc.; bills are highlighted to show what bills were updated.

- Sharin the list will not include notes.
- Downloads will include what is on the page; click show notes to include in a download.
- All information is linkable on the composite view and the downloaded report – Bill number, patron, committee and votes
